- DO NOT ALLOW ANY HEAT OR OPEN FLAMES TO COME IN CONTACT WITH THE MATERIAL OF THIS HUNTING BLIND.
- DO NOT USE A HEATER IN BLIND. UNVENTED FUMES CAN CAUSE SICKNESS OR DEATH.
- DO NOT SHOOT AN FIREARM THOUGH THE SHOOT THROUGH SCREENS, THE MUZZLE FLASH COULD IGNIGTE THE SCREEN MATERIAL
- DO NOT USE EXPANDABLE BROADHEADS WITH SHOOT-THROUGH SCREENS, THE BLADES MAY OPEN PREMATURELY. USE FIXED BLADE BROADHEAD USE ONLY
- DO NOT ALLOW CHILDREN TO PLAY WITH THIS BLIND WITHOUT ADULT SUPERVISION.
- NEVER COVER YOUR FACE WITH THE BLIND MATERIAL. IT CAN CAUSE SUFFOCATION AND DEATH.

## SET UP

### STEP 1

**Warning: Blind contains spring steel under tension. Use caution when unfolding blind.**

Remove blind from carrying case and lay it on the ground. Carefully unfold the blind. It will unravel and pop into shape. (Illustration 1)  
Spread the walls. (Illustration 2)

### STEP 2

Assemble the 2-roof poles. Insert one end of each pole in the pocket located in each inside corner. Make sure to cross the poles in the center on the roof. (Illustration 3)

For windy conditions it is recommended that the adjustable tie-down cords and stakes be used to secure the blind. Insert the ground stakes through the attached loops on the bottom of the blind. Secure adjustable tie-down cords with stakes and adjust the cords so they are tight.

## SET UP continued

### Tie-down Cord

#### STEP 1

Use the adjustment buckles and adjust the cords to match the pictures. (Illustration 1)

#### STEP 2

Tie the tie-down rope to the loops on the corners of the blind. Insert the stake through the loop at the end of the tie-down rope. Press the stakes into the ground, and adjust the buckle as needed to secure the blind. (Illustration 2)

## Tear Down

#### STEP 1

Remove all stakes and roof poles. Place all 4-walls together as in illustration 1.

#### STEP 2

Place bottom of blind a couple of feet in front of you. Grab the sides of the walls at about the 10 and 2 o'clock positions and begin to fold the blind over at about the mid-point. Fold until top of blind is about 2 feet from the ground (Illustration 2)

**STEP 3**

Place your hands so your knuckles are facing each other. Bring the edges together where your hands are placed. They will start to form the loops that will lie on top of one another. (Illustration 3)

**STEP 4**

Overlap the sides as you bring them together by turning your hands, but not letting go of the blind, so your knuckles face away from you. The top loop will fold under the sides. (Illustration 4 and 5)

**STEP 5**

Lay the loops down flat. Even out the loops so they are all approximately the same size. This will ensure that you will be able to easily fit the blind back into the carrying case. (Illustration 6)

**Storage**

- Never store a wet or damp blind in its carrying case. Make sure blind is completely dry before storing.
- Be sure blind is free of debris before packing into carrying case.
- Store blind in a dry and cool place.
